RULES & REGULATIONS OF COMPETITION

1. Any objections must be submitted by 12noon Tuesday 7th July 2008 accompanied by a deposit of £1.00 which shall be forfeited if the objection is unsuccessful.
2. The Show will be open to the public on:
 - Tuesday 7th July from 09.00am (The marquee will open at 10.00am, judging to take place from 9.00am)
 - Wednesday 8th July from 09.00am
 - Thursday 9th July from 09.00am
 - Friday 10th July from 09.00am
3. No exhibit will be lifted for any reason before 5pm on Friday 10th July
4. All exhibits must be cleared by 8.00pm on Saturday 11th July.
5. RASE shall not be responsible for any accident, damage or loss, however caused, that may be sustained by an exhibitor or representative being brought into or leaving the show site.
6. Each exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any loss, damage or injuries that may be caused by any show representative or articles that have been brought into the show, and shall indemnify the Society and RASE Council from any legal actions or claims that may arise.
7. Winning exhibitors can claim their prize money, which will be paid in cash, from Steward's Table in the Flower Show marquee on Friday 10th July from 4pm. (Access to Showground through any gate from 4pm onwards, Show closes at 5pm.)
8. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that all class tickets are securely fastened or fixed to their exhibit.
9. All entries will have the name of the exhibitor displayed on the entry tag and will be revealed after judging is completed. Block entries from organisations are not acceptable.
10. Exhibitors will be able to access the venue from 8.00am Monday to 8.00pm in order to bench their entries. Exhibitors will be provided with appropriate passes to allow them access to the Showground before and after the Show. Entry during the Show can only be achieved by presenting an admission ticket - **One ticket** will be issued to each entrant and additional tickets may be purchased in advance.
11. Once all exhibits have been staged they shall not be moved other than by a Show Steward of Council Officer. Anyone contravening this rule shall be disqualified from the Show.
12. The Show will be under the rules of the RHS.
13. The judges will have the right to withhold or modify any prize should the exhibit, in the judges' opinion, not be considered worthy of a prize.
14. Any exhibit found to have infestation of pests or disease will be disqualified and removed from the exhibition area.
15. In all cases the Judges' decision shall be final.
